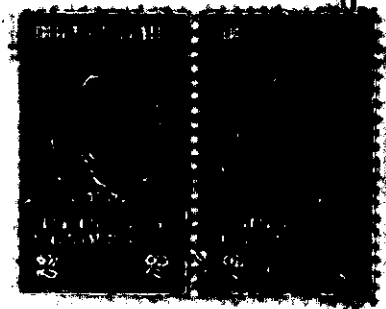
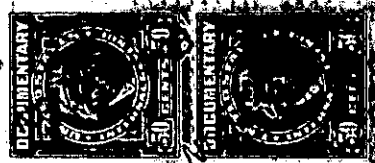
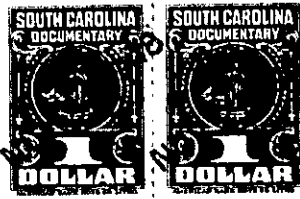

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret M. Green,  
her heirs and assigns forever:-

All my undivided one-half right, title and interest of, in and to  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, School District 9-H, on the north side of  
Emma (Now Poinsett) Street, in the City of Greer, adjoining lands  
now or formerly of Claude Duncan, of Guy Pugh and of George Beason,  
and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at a stone 3x, the northwestern corner of this lot, and runs
