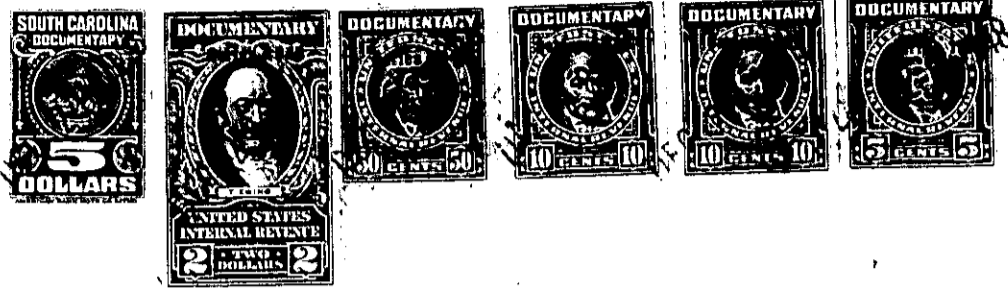

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Tract No. 3 of the J. M. McClure Estate, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a pine stump, corner of A. D. Pruitt and running thence S 77 3/4 W. 6.50 chs. to stake on gully; thence up said gully N. 44 W. 2.50 chs. to stake; thence N. 7 W. 2.80 chs. to a stake; thence N. 37 W. 3.50 chs. to a stake; thence N. 70 E. 17.50 chs. to an iron pin; thence S. 20 E. 6.80 chs. to a stake; thence S. 17 E. 5.25 chs. to a stake; thence S. 2.30 chs. to a stake; thence S. 12 E. 3.13 chs. to a stake; thence S. 1 1/2 E. 7.12 chs. to a stake in road; thence N. 44 W. 16.00 chs. to pine stump, the beginning corner, containing 22 acres, more or less.
