to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto FRANKLIN E. GRIFFITH AND KATHRYN M. GRIFFITH, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Western side of Louise Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 64 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 39, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Louise Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots No. 63 and 64 and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 26-39 W. 243 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 67; thence along the rear line of Lots No. 67 and 66, N. 53-48 E. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 64 and 65; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, S. 37-35 E. 284.3 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Louise Avenue; thence along the Western side of Louise Avenue S. 73-50 W. 130 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The property herein conveyed is subject to the restrictive covenants which are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 243, at page 146, reference to which is hereby made.

This being part of the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by Victor-Monaghan Company by deed dated August 31, 1946, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 298, at page 339.
