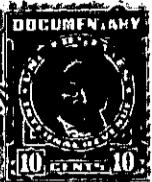
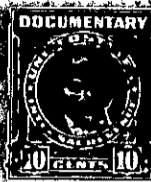

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. M. Nabors

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by E. T. Roach and Grace W. Roach

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have grant d, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. T. Roach and Grace W. Roach

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 11-C, on the west side of Little Texas Road, according to a plat made by G. A. Ellis (P.E.S.) 1944, and containing twenty (20) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Little Texas Road, corner lands of B. F. Drummond, and running thence with B. F. Drummond line N. 76 W. 890 feet to a stake; thence S. 21-46 W. 760 feet to an iron pin, corner lands now or formerly of Nabors; thence with Nabors line S. 70-1/2 E. 1155 feet to an iron pin, corner of Robinson land; thence with Robinson line N. 2-0 E. 840 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
