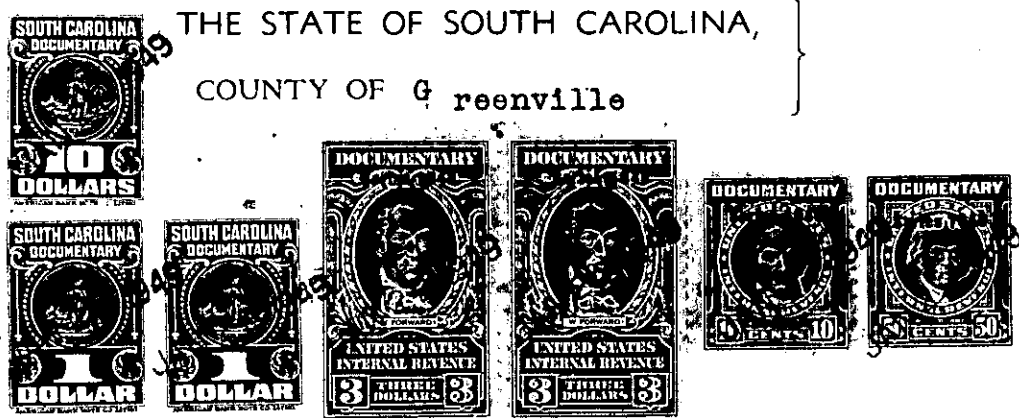

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ben H. Bishop

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township. Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer, and on the West side of Hill Crest Drive which leads off from the Spartanburg-Greenville Super-Highway, and designated as lot #9 on plat of the W. E. Mc Intyre property, prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, March 13th, 1939, and thereon delineated as follows:

Beginning at iron pin on the western edge of said Hill Crest Drive cornering with lands of Campbell, and running thence with Campbell line, S 79-00 W Five Hundred ninety-one and five-tenths (591.5) feet to stone and iron pin; thence with line of Earle Dill property, S 26-46 E fifty (50) feet to iron pin on said line; thence with the line of lot #8 on said plat, S 86-51 W five hundred forty-four and five-tenths (544.5) feet on western edge of Hill Crest Drive; thence with the said Drive, N 5-40 E one hundred and twenty-nine (129) feet to the beginning corner.
