

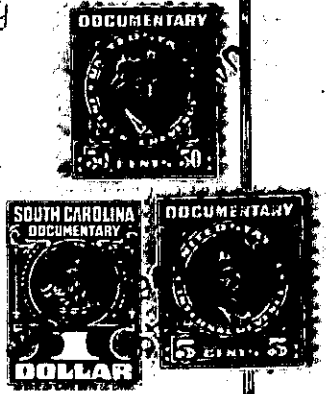

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$373.33

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Raymond Leroy Smith,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, containing twenty-five (25) acres, more
or less, bounded by the A.W. McDavid, L. Lenhardt and William Hammett
Lands, being about fourteen miles from Greenville Court House and near
the Augusta Road and being the same tract of land conveyed to R. J.
Anderson by A. W. McDavid on December 29, 1923 and recorded in the RMC
Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 97, at page 601.
