

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 17.1 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of land belonging to P. W. Burdine about 5 chains from a branch, thence N = 31 = 3/4W 15.80 chains along the boundary line of lands belonging to the aforesaid P. W. Burdine and Mrs. Sam Bynum to a stake Hy gone, on line of L. J. Bynum land; thence N 86 1/2 W 4.80 along the line of L. J. Bynum lands to stone OM; thence S 42 1/2 W 6.40 chains along the line of Bowen lands to stone OM; thence S 21 E across branch 5.25 chains to dogwood X3; thence S 40 E 3.00 chains to iron pin; thence S 37 1/2 E 7.55 chains along the boundary line of the Crow lands to iron pin; thence N 59 E 9.85 across branch to iron pin at point of beginning, all of which will fully appear by reference to plat of W.
