

acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release

unto the said Most Reverend Emmet M. Walsh as The Bishop of Charleston, a corporation sole as aforesaid, and his successors in the Episcopal See of Charleston according to the discipline and government of the Roman Catholic Church, and his and their assigns:

ALL those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Douthit Street and Lawton Avenue, being known and designated as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of property formerly of J. A. Bull, et al. A plat of this property entitled "Property of J. A. Bull, Greenville, S. C." prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, June 11, 1942, is to be recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and reference is hereby made to said recorded plat for a more particular description. The property herein conveyed is also shown on a plat prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., C. E., dated April 6, 1929, entitled "Property of J.F. and W. E. Berry" and recorded in Plat Book H, at page 162. The lots herein conveyed are shown on said plat as Lots 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

ALSO together with any right, title or interest of the grantor in and to a strip of land known as Lawton Avenue appurtenant to Lots 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 as shown on the aforesaid plat prepared by W. J. Riddle and entitled "Property of J. A. Bull, Greenville, S. C."

The property herein conveyed was conveyed to the grantor by two separate deeds: Deed of J. A. Bull, Dan H. Bull and Margaret Bull dated January 1, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C.
