

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of **Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00)** Dollars,

to me paid by the said **Mrs. Lucia Rose Plumblee**

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. Lucia Rose Plumblee

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Highland Township on the East side of the Old State Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a state in the center of the old State road, and running thence with said road, N. $40\frac{1}{2}$ W. 9 rods to a point in said road; thence N. $41\frac{1}{2}$ E. 38 rods to a stone corner; thence in a southerly direction 17 rods and 8 feet to a stone; thence N. 68 W. 38 rods to the beginning corner.

(Being a part of the land conveyed by George W. Westmoreland to G. W. Neves, and the same conveyed by G. W. Neves. to Mountain View Gin, and being the same land deeded by J. W. Gray, Master to B. M. Lindsey under deed of August 2, 1909, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Book WWW, Page 320, and being likewise the same tract of land as was conveyed to J. C. Cox by B. M. Lindsey by deed dated January 8, 1913. The said lot or parcel of land containing 3 acres, more or less, and is known as the old Gin Site."

The above description is the same as containing in the deed of E. Inman, Master to G. L. Lister dated February 10, 1945, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 272, at Page 154."
