I92 feet: thence S.64-45 W.290 feet; thence S.'83- 0 W. 600 feet to corner on Burdette line in center of road, (line marked by stake on bank of road I5 feet from center of road); thence N.I- 45 E. II73 feet with Burbette line to the begining corner.
