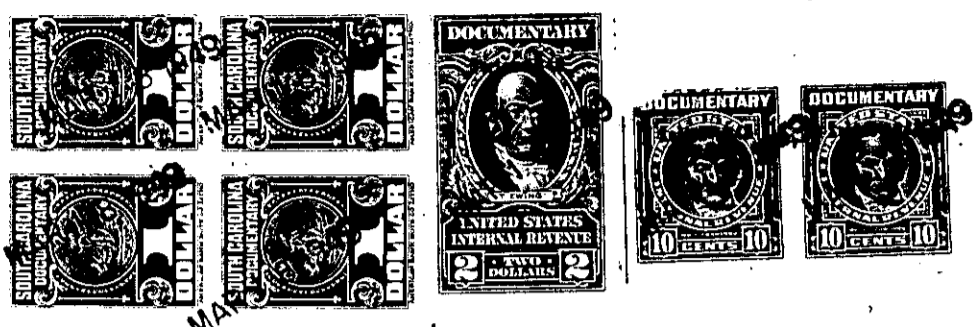

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ethel C. Yates and her heirs and.....
assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of J. C. Roe, Clyde Hester and others,
and described according to a plat of the same made by J. A. Hester, Surveyor,
November 28, 1928, as follows:

BEGINNING at a bridge on Hillhouse Creek on the West side of Buncombe Road,
and running down said creek S. 62 W. 1.00 to a bend; thence with said creek
S. 51 1/2 W. 2.20 to a bend in said creek; thence with said creek S. 83 W. 1.63
to a Black Gum stump on the bank of said creek; thence S. 50 3/4 E. 6.50 to a
stone in ditch on Buncombe Road; thence along the West side of Buncombe Road
N. 8 W. 6.22 to the beginning corner, containing 1.35 acres, more or less.
