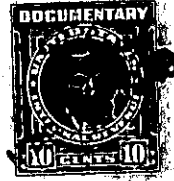
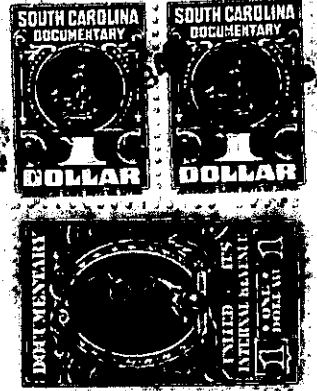

Zonolite Company

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 1.46 acres, more or less, according to a plat of survey made by H. S. Brockman, March 4, 1949 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book V Page 85 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake at the joint corner of property of E. B. League and other property of the Grantee herein and running thence along the line of other property of the Grantee S. 56-30 E. 168 feet to the center of the main track of the Greenville and Knoxville Railroad and running thence with the center of the main track of the Greenville and Knoxville Railroad S. 11-27 E. 416 feet to a point in the center of the main track; thence continuing with the center of said track S. 10-37 E. 37 feet; thence along the line of other property of E. B. League N. 68-18 W. 177.6 feet to a stake; thence N. 7-51 W. 475 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property is conveyed subject to the right of way of Greenville and Knoxville Railroad, said right-of-way being 40 feet wide and extending 20 feet on each side of the center of main track.

The Grantee agrees to pay all taxes for the year 1949.
