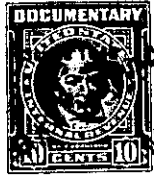

by W. F. Gresham  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. F. Gresham

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, Located on the East side of South Street  
in the Town of Simpsonville, S. C., adjoining lands now owned  
by G. W. Chandler, Oscar C. Haymes and C. B. Cole, Jr., and  
more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of South Street, corner  
of lot now owned by C. B. Cole, Jr., and running thence along the  
East side of South Street fifty-five (55) feet, more or less to an  
iron pin, joint corner with lot now owned by G. W. Chandler (Formerly  
owned by J. W. Alexander); thence along line of G. W. Chandler  
is a northerly direction ninety-one (91) feet to line of lot now  
owned by Oscar C. Haymes (Formerly G. B. Riddle); thence with  
line of Haymes eighty-five (85) feet in a southeasterly direction  
to an iron pin; thence in a southwesterly direction along line of  
Haymes and line of Cole, one hundred feet to an iron pin on South  
Street, the point of beginning, there being situate on the within  
described premises a two room dwelling.
