FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is (1) Repair, modification and manufacturing of machinery, engines and motors; (2) To engineer, manufacture and repair all types of dies, gages, templates, jigs and fixtures; (3) To contract for the erection, installation and maintenance of machinery at any point away from the established place of business; (4) to manufacture and do engineering work on tanks, boilers, columns, trusses and general structural steel work; (5) To contract for the manufacture of parts and sub-assemblies for industry; (6) To engage in all types of the following operations: (a)Welding, (b)general machining, (c)Foundry and forge work, (d)Heat treating, (e) woodworking; (7) To perform engineering and design service; (8) to engage in the buying and selling of machinery; (9) To maintain shops and offices; (1) To purchase, sell and encumber real estate pertaining to the business aforesaid.
