DEED

WHEREAS, Nelson C. Poe died testate on February 17, 1931, leaving of force his last Will and Testament, bearing date July 3, 1926, which Will was admitted to probate in common form by the Probate Court, Greenville County, South Carolina, on February 26, 1931, said Will being filed in the Office of the Probate Judge, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apartment #271, File #16, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Nelson C. Foe directed in Item VI of his Will that the residuum of his estate, both real and personal, be divided among his three children, Melson C. Poe, Jr., Ellen Poe and William Wilkins Poe, in equal portions, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Nelson C. Foe died seized and possessed of the property hereinafter described, said property constituting a portion of the residuum of his estate, and

on July 20, 1947, leaving of force his last Will and Testament, bearing date June 13, 1947, which Will was admitted to probate in common form by the Probate Court, Greenville County, South Carolina, on July 29, 1947, said Will being filed in the Office of the Probate Judge, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apartment #532, File #22, and

WHEREAS, the said William Wilkin's Foe in Item VIII of his Will named Belle Eskew Poe and The South Carolina
