All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Laurens Ruad about five miles Southeast of the City of Greenville, in mustin Township, Creenville County, S. C., containing 2 acros according to survey made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, April 1949, and naving according to said plat the following metas and bounds, to-wit:
