----- dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. C. Hill, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being on the West side of Altamont Road, in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Section B of plat of Paris Mountain-Caesars' Head Company made by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, and other according to a recent survey and plat made by J. C. Hill, the boundaries of which are and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap on the Western edge of Altamont Road, at the Southeast corner of property now or formerly of Crooks, beginning thence along line of Crooks property S. 22-10 E. 297.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-24 E. 511.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-15 E. 461.2 feet to nail and cap on the Southwest edge of Altamont Road; thence along a curving course with the Western edge of Altamont Road as the boundary in a Northwesterly direction 350 feet to nail and cap, containing 3.75 acres more or less.
