(2) No hogs or cows are to be kept on said premises.

(3) Said property shall not be used in such manner as would constitute a

nuisance or annoyance to other property owners in Wildwood Park.

(4) Intoxicating beverages shall not be manufactured or sold on said property. (5) Grantee shall make sanitary disposition of sewerage refuse and shall not permit the same to empty into creeks or streams.

These restrictions are not intended as conditions subsequent but are for protection of the adjacent property owners of Wildwood Park.

This conveyance is made subject to the right of Edwin McT. Meares, his heirs or assigns to enter upon the above described property for the purpose of containing an uninterupted flow of water along the stream which leads to his property.

This conveyance is subject to such rights as may have heretofore been granted by the grantor herein to any property owner in Wildwood Park.
