Bruce, Dwight L. Braggs and J. T. Gillespie or their successors, for the Missions Committee of Greenville County.

All that piece, parcel <sup>two</sup> of lots of land in GREENVILLE Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Lee Road, being known and designated as Lot #7 and Lot #8 as shown on plat of the property of James M. Edwards, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, in February 1941, and being more particularly described according to said plat, as follows:

Lot #7: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Lee Road, joint front corners of Lots #7 and #8, and running thence with the line of Lot #8, S. 17-10 E. 313.8' to an iron pin in line of Lot #6; thence with the line of Lot #6, N. 73-29 E. 80' to an iron pin; thence N. 13-07 W. 314' to an iron pin on Lee Road; thence with the southern side of Lee Road, S. 73-44 W. 100' to the beginning corner.

Lot #8: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Lee Road, at joint front corners of Lots #8 and #9, and running thence with the line of Lot #9, S. 17-10 W. 314' to an iron pin, corner of Lot #6; thence with the line of Lot #7, N. 17-10 W. 313.8' to a pin on Lee Road; thence with the southern side of Lee Road, S. 73-44 W. 100' to the beginning corner.
