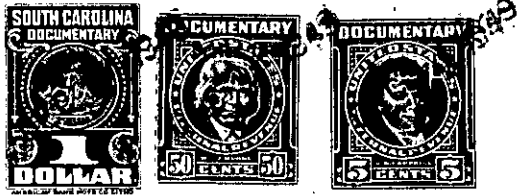

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Paul G. Moore and Milton D. Moore,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty-five (\$325.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Keith L. Moore

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Keith L. Moore, his Heirs

and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one mile north from Greer, lying on the east side of the Mosteller Road, being bounded on the north and east by lands of Mrs. Moore, on the south by lands of Vernon Duncan, and on the west by the said Mosteller Road, in Greer School District No. 9-H, and being the same land that was conveyed to us by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 306 at page 408, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the center of the said Mosteller Road, joint corner of the Vernon Duncan land, and runs thence with the Duncan line, S. 84-00 E. 236.5 feet to an iron pin on the Duncan line and joint corner of Mrs. Moore's land; thence with the line of Mrs. Moore N. 84-45 E. 160 feet to an iron pin, Mrs. Moore's corner; thence with another line of Mrs. Moore N. 84-00 W. 197.5 feet to a point in the center of the Mosteller road; thence with the said road S. 19-15 W. 164 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Eight Tenths (0.8) of one acre, more or less.
