KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Carolina Association of Seventh-
Day Adventist, a North Carolina Corporation
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of North Carolina
and having its principal place of business at
Charlotte in the State of North Carolina for and in consideration
of the sum of Ten Thousand and no/100. (\$10,000.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Gordon B. Riley,
his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements
thereon, lying and being on the Southwesterly side of Byrd Blvd. in the City of
Greenville, S. C., being shown as part of lot 158 on the plat of Craxler Park,
recorded in the REC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book "F", pages
114 and 115 and having according to a plat made by R. W. Dalton, registered L.S.,
on October 27, 1929, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwesterly side of Byrd Blvd. 279.7 feet in an East-
erly direction from the intersection of Byrd Blvd. and Augusta Road, joint front
corner of lots 158 and 159 and thence along the Southwest side of Byrd Blvd. S 67-
50 E 77 feet to a stake; thence S 26-03 W 278.5 feet to a stake on the line of lot
102 N 52-08 W 45.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 102 and 103;
thence along the line of lot 103 N 52-56 W 11.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear
corner of lot 159; thence along the line of lot 157 N 20-51 E 234.6 feet to the
point of beginning.

This property was conveyed to the grantor herein by the deed recorded in Deeds
372, page 411.

This deed is executed pursuant to a resolution duly adopted at a meeting of the
Executive Committee of the Grantor which was duly held at Kings Mountain, North
Carolina on August 28, 1929.
