

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Ebaugh Avenue at the intersection of a 10-foot alley with Ebaugh Avenue, and running thence along the southwest side of Ebaugh Avenue, N. 17-30 W. 36 feet to an iron pin at a bend in said Ebaugh Avenue; thence still along the southwest side of Ebaugh Avenue, N. 57 W. 44.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 113 and 114; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 73-30 W. 128.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the line of Lot No. 112, S. 17-30 E. 60 feet to an iron pin on a ten-foot alley; thence along the line of said alley, N. 73-30 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner.
