wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said line all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper maintenance and operation of the same.
