KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, I, Manning W. Chamblee,
 a legal resident of the (Town, city, or county) of Fountain Inn
 State of South Carolina, United States of America, now in the naval serv-
 ice as a Chief Gunner's Mate, Service No. 261 90.06, in the
 service of the United States, and anticipating that a Power of Attorney
 may be useful in certain circumstances, have made, constituted and ap-
 pointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Grace C.
Woods, whose address is Fountain Inn, South Caro-
lina, my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage,
 and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose for me
 and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my
 act and deed, to do and execute, or concur with persons jointly interest-
 ed with myself there in the doing or executing of, all or any of the fol-
 lowing acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:

(1) To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire; to sell,
 convey, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claim or otherwise encumber
 or dispose of; any property whatsoever or any custody, possession, inter-
 est, or right therein, upon such terms as my said attorney shall think
 proper; (2) To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, or let, or otherwise
 manage any or all of my property or any interest therein; to eject, re-
 move, or relieve tenants or other persons or anything from, and recover
 possession of, such property by all lawful means; and to maintain, pro-
 tect, preserve, insure, remove, store, transport, repair, rebuild, modi-
 fy, or improve the same or any part thereof; (3) To make, do, and trans-
 act all and every kind of business of what nature or kind soever, in-
 cluding the receipt, recovery, collection, payment, compromise, settle-
 ment and adjustment of all accounts, legacies, bequests, interests, div-
 idends, annuities, demands, debts, taxes, and obligations, which may now
 or hereafter be due, owing, or payable by me or to me; (4) To make, in-
 dorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and deliver
 deeds, assignments, agreements, certificates, hypothecations, checks,
 notes, bonds, vouchers, receipts, and such other instruments in writing
 of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary, convenient, or proper
 in the premises; (5) To deposit and withdraw for the purpose hereof, in
 either my said attorney's name or my name or jointly in both our names,
 in or from any banking institution, any funds, negotiable paper, or mon-
 eys which may come into my attorney's hands as such attorney or which I
 now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to; (6) To insti-
 tute, prosecute, defend, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal,
 equitable, or administrative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, ar-
 rests, distresses or other proceedings, or otherwise engage in litiga-
 tion in connection with the premises; (7) To act as my attorney or proxy
 in respect to any stocks, shares, bonds, or other investments, rights,
 or interests, I may now or hereafter hold; (8) To engage and dismiss
 agents, counsel, and employees, and to appoint and remove at pleasure
 any substitute for, or agent of my said attorney, in respect to all or
 any of the matters or things herein mentioned and upon such terms as my
 attorney shall think fit; (9) To execute vouchers in my behalf for any
 and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the
 United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimburse-
 ment for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household ef-
 fects as authorized by law or Navy regulations, and to receive, indorse,
 and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the Under-
 signed drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; (10) To prepare,
 execute, and file income and other tax returns, and other governmental
 reports, applications, requests, and documents; (11) To take possession
 and order the removal and shipment, of any of my property from any
 post, warehouse, depot, dock, or other place of storage or safe keeping,
 governmental or private; and to execute and deliver any release, vouch-
 ers, receipt, shipping ticket, certificate, or other instrument neces-
 sary or convenient for such purpose.
