the center of Tindal Road; thence with Tindal Road in the following courses and distances: S. 8-55 W. 54.5 feet; S. 19-17 E. 177.5 feet; S. 2-42 East 150 feet; S. 2-26 W. 400 feet; S. 13-33 W. 799 feet; S. 21-10 West 150 feet; S. 25-53 W. 352 feet; S. 14-06 W. 278 feet; S. 28-26 W. 160 feet; S. 36-54 W. 349 feet to a point where Langston's Creek crosses said Tindal Road; thence with Langston's Creek in an easterly direction 2400 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and containing 53 acres, more or less. This property is conveyed subject to the right-of-way of the Duke Power Company."

"This property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions:

- "1. No whiskey shall be sold upon the above described premises.
- "2. No public dance hall or other similar place shall be operated on the above described premises.
- "3. In addition to the consideration shown above the purchaser has paid \$250.12 to the account of the Defendant, Henry Tindal, which was disbursed by the Attorneys for the Plaintiff to cover his share of the Court cost, attorneys fee and stamps on deed, as provided for in the Decree of Court herein.
