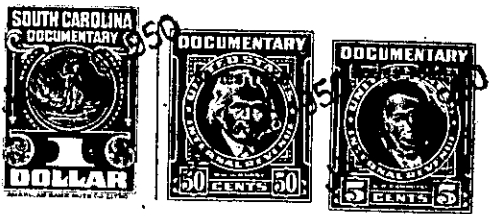

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **H. E. Hembree, his heirs, and**
assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Butler** Township, **Greenville**
County, State of South Carolina, on the **Southwest side of Sycamore Drive,**
near the City of Greenville, being designated as lot no. 115 on
a plat of East Lynne Addition, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers,
May, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, S. C. in plat book H at page 220, and having, according
to said plat the following metes, and bounds, to-wit:
