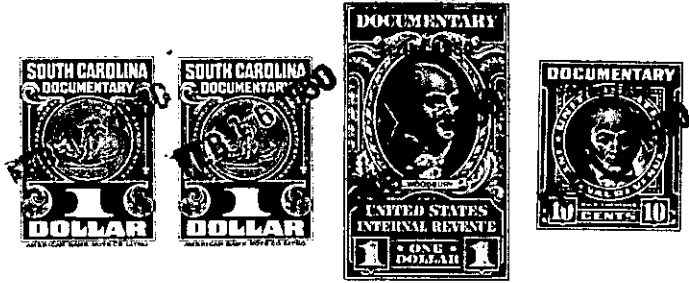

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sam P. Davis, his Heirs and
Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, within the corporate limits of the City of
Greenville and being known and designated as lot No. 51 of a sub-
division known as Vista Hills, a Plat of which is of record in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", page 149, and
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the Northeastern intersection of
Kent Lane and County (Gilfillin) Road, and running thence
N. 1-50 W., 90 feet to a point on the Eastern side of Kent
Lane, said point being the joint front corners of lots Nos.
51 and 52; thence N. 88-10 E., 175 feet to a point, said
point being the joint rear corners of lots Nos. 51 and 52;
thence S. 1-50 E., 50.1 feet to a point on the Northern side of
County (Gilfillin) Road; thence S. 75-20 W., 179.5 feet along
the Northern side of County (Gilfillin) Road to the point of
