in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William E. Cashion and Evelyn C. Cashion, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Bates Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of Block G of a subdivision of Slater Village as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Mellon Street at the corner of Lot No. 27, and running thence along the line of that lot, N. 87-24 E. 125 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 2, of Block G, N. 2-37 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 25; thence along the line of that lot, S. 87-24 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Mellon street; thence along the line of said Mellon street, S. 2-37 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is the same conveyed to us by Joe T. Smith by deed dated October 29, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 363, page 352.
