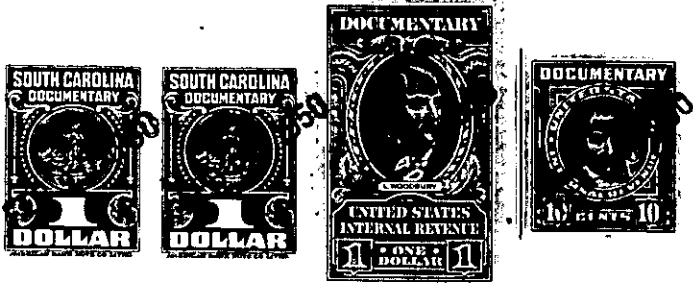

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. R. Taber

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$775.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by William Vaughn and R. B. Vaughn

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Vaughn and R. B. Vaughn

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as Lot No. 6 on a plat of the subdivision of Tract No. 1 of the Overbrook Land Company made by Dalton & Neves, June, 1924, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Overbrook Road, joint corner of Lot Nos. 5 and 6 and running thence S. 55-42 E. 167 feet to a point on the side line of Lot No. 30; thence along the line of Lot No. 30 S. 29-01 W. 110 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 6 and 7; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 N. 39-14 W. 176.1 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Overbrook Road; thence along the eastern line of said Overbrook Road N. 26-17 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning. The plat mentioned above is recorded in Plat Book K, Page 59, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. B. League, A. D. Ashbury and others as Trustees of School District 17-A of the City of Greenville by deed dated September 16, 1946, recorded in Deed Book 299, page 189.

The grantees are to pay 1950 taxes.
