all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, about six miles from the city of Greenville,
near the White Horse Road, containing 15 1/2 acres more or less, and
being part of the Old Thompson Lands, and having, according to survey
and plat made by W. A. Hester dated April 18, 1941, the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Old White Horse Road and running
thence with said road S 21 E 2.55 chains to a stake on proposed
new 30 foot road; thence with said proposed 30 foot road N
49 E 19.22 chains to a stake; thence N 24-1/2 E 2.90 chains
to a stake; thence in a southeasterly direction 5 chains, more
or less, to a stone OM; thence S 28 W 17 chains to an iron
