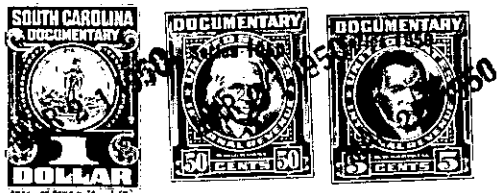

County, State of South Carolina all of our right title, and interest in and to
our undividen portion of the following described real estate.

All of that piece, parcel or tract of land in Bates township
known as a part of the land conveyed to S.A. Guest by S.F. Guest.
Adjoining lands now or formerly owned by S.A. Guest and John
Langford. Beginning on a stake in the Pumpkintown Road, and running
with said road N.87 E 316 feet to a stake; thence S. 3 E 317 feet
