in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$700.00)----- DOLLARS,

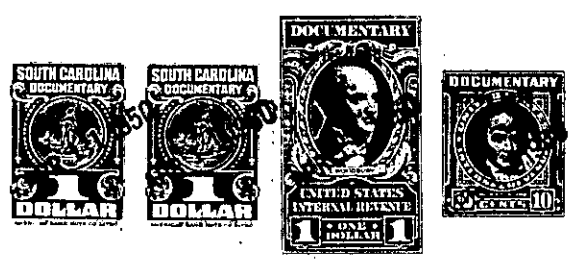

Jackson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 17 as shown on plat of Eliza T. Looper land prepared by R.E. Dalton in December 1924, recorded in Plat Book H at Pages 159 and 160, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Washington Avenue, 59 feet Southeast from the Southeast intersection of Washington Avenue and Wilson Street, joint front corner of lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with joint line of said lots, N. 71-17 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-00 E. 59 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 71-17 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Washington Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 22-00 W. 59 feet to the point of beginning.
