

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dials & Fairview Township, Laurens & Greenville

County, State of South Carolina and containing seventy-nine and seventy-four one hundredths (79.74) acres, more or less, bounded now or formerly by lands of Thomas Cooper, Tobe Garrett estate, W. W. Kellett, Roberts, Godfrey and others, and being about 4 miles Northeast of Fountain Inn, on the road from Fountain Inn to Bethany Church, with the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at Northern corner, hickory near the County line between Laurens and Greenville Counties, running thence S. 17-30 E. 41.43 to a stone; thence 66-30 W. 18.30 to a point in creek; thence up the creek N. 8-15 W. 8.98 to bend; thence N. 0-45 E. 4.52 to stake; thence; thence N. 55 W. 23.40 to a stone; thence N. 51-15 E. 31.80 to the point of beginning.
