the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Ernest J. Gosnell**

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, beginning at a stone on Panther Branch, waters of Terry Creek, and running thence S. 73 W. 4.00 chains to a stone; thence S. 30 E. 3.00 chains to an angle in old road; thence S. 39 E. 3.00 chains to an angle in old road; thence S. 30 E. 1.66 chains to a stone; thence S. 67 E. 2.85 chains to a chestnut stump and stone; thence S. 28 E. 2.10 chains to Panther Branch; thence north-west along the said Branch as the line 11.57 chains to the point of beginning, and containing 3.5 acres, more or less, according to a survey of the same made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, on March 3, 1923, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Sallie Ballew by Mitchell Bryant by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 97, at page 377."
