WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT ROBERT L. WALDROP and BERNICE B. WALDROP, his wife, of

in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and
valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm to Shell Oil
Company, a Delaware corporation with offices at 50 West 50th Street,
New York, New York, hereinafter called "Grantee", its successors and
assigns, the following described premises situated in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land fronting on both East Washington Street or Road and Laurens Road in the City of Greenville; County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds according to a recent survey by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in April 1950, to-wit:
