with all apparatus and equipment forming a part of the street lighting circuit of the grantor serving said Village. It is understood that the personal property constituting a part of such distribution lines and system other than that aforementioned shall remain the property of the Grantor and may be disposed of as it sees fit.

The Grantee shall have the right and privilege of removing, dismantling and delivering to the Grantor, or disposing of for the benefit and account of the Grantor, any and all personal property constituting a part of the lines and systems above described other than the items aforementioned and hereby sold and transferred to the Grantee, except personal property belonging to the Grantor included within the exceptions hereinafter mentioned.

There is excepted from this conveyance, and the Grantee shall neither remove nor dismantle any part of the following described circuits:

- (i) All circuits running from any service substation to and for the service of any industrial building or executive or managerial office of the Grantor.
- (ii) That circuit in the Greenville plant village of the Grantor running from the substation to the employment office and to the parking area on the southern side of Cain (East Main) Street in said village.
- (iii) That circuit running from the substation serving the Greenville plant of the Grantor to and for the service of the ball park located in the Grantor's Greenville plant village.
- (iv) That circuit running from the industrial properties of the Grantor known as its Greenville plant to a pump located near the northern side of South Sixth Street.
- (v) That circuit running from the pole in the mill yard of the Simpsonville plant of the Grantor to a pump in the rear of houses fronting on Fourth Street in the Town of Simpsonville, South Carolina.
- (vi) All street lighting circuits serving the Greenville plant village of the Grantor near the City of Greenville, South Carolina.
- (2) The right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the land, streets, alleys, and ways within the areas of the mill villages known as the Greenville, Simpsonville, and Fountain Inn plant villages of the Grantor, and to maintain, use and operate the said electric distribution lines and systems and street lighting circuits as the same are now located and installed, or as the same may be reconstructed, extended or relocated in accordance with reconstruction plans prepared by the Grantee for the Greenville, Simpsonville, and Fountain Inn plants of the Grantor, dated, respectively, July 29, 1949, June 13, 1949, and March 7, 1949, which by reference are made a part hereof, and to construct, maintain
