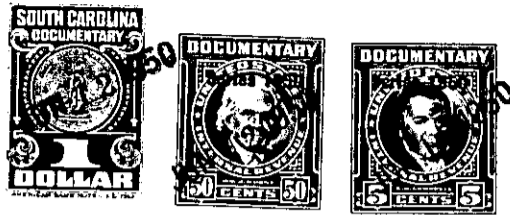

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 83 on
a revised Map of Parker Heights made by Dalton & Neves, May 1946,
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book
"D", page 43, and having, according to said Map, the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of
Calhoun Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 83
and 84, and running thence with line of lot
No. 84, N. 59-15 W., 150 feet to an iron pin,
joint corner of lots Nos. 83, 84, 93 and 94;
thence with rear line of lot No. 94, N. 30-45 E.,
50 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots
Nos. 82 and 83; thence with line of lot No.
82, S. 59-45 W., 150 feet to an iron pin on
the North side of Calhoun Avenue; thence with Cal-
houn Avenue, S. 30-45 W., 50 feet to an iron pin,
the beginning corner.
