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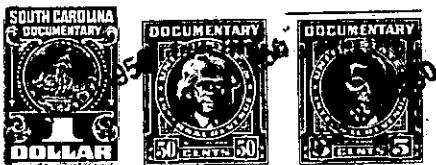

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto David G. Traxler, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #121, Pleasant Valley, according to plat of said sub-division prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946, including additions to said Plat through February, 1950, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 88, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots #120 and #121, said pin being 410 feet Northeast of iron pin in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge Avenue with Panama Avenue; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #120 and #121; thence N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #121 and #122; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #121 and #122 on the Southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence along said Avenue S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #120 and #121, the point of beginning.

The herein named grantee is to pay the 1950 taxes on the above-described property.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

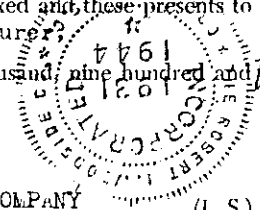
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and successors, heirs and assigns forever.
