HEGINNING at a stone (iron pin) in the center of settlement road entering the farm, corner of M. G. Verdin and Estate of Mrs. Gertrude F. Verdin, and running thence S. 84 W. 7.75 to a stone; thence S. 83-15 W. to a stone; corner R. C. Kendrick; thence along Kendricks line N. 19 W. 20.00 to a point in center of Peters Creek, popular on south bank; thence down the meanders of said creek N. 81-30 E. as the line 3.35 to bend; thence still down the center of said creek as the line N. 66 E. 7.78 to a point in the center of the creek, M. G. Verdin corner; thence along Verdin line S. 11-45 E. 22.09 to the beginning corner, containing 20.20 acres be the same more or less, according to a copy of plat of survey made for the Federal Land Bank of Columbia by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, on June 20, 1919.

This Conveyance carries with it an easment of right of way for the purpose of ingress and egress through, over and across property situate in Austin Township, County & State Aforesaid, from the above described tract of land, beginning at the southeast corner (stone) and extending therefrom through lands of present grantee, O. P. Anders and C. F. Verdin to a settlement road leading from the Greenville-Woodruff highway to the farm of M. G. Verdin said easment being the same as was granted to J. T. & Ola C. Cromer be deed from M. G. Verdin and C. F. Verdin dated Nov. 8, 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 240 at page 325.
