

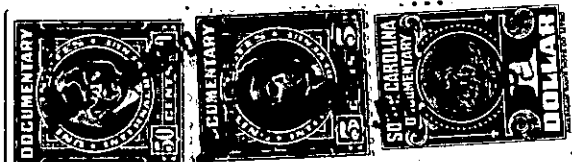

County, State of South Carolina

All that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, which is bounded and described as follows:

All that tract of land located in West Greenville, which has now become a part of the City of Greenville, and on the western side of Bob Street which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on Bob Street and running thence N. 20 E. 55' to an I.P.; thence N. 67-30 W. 154.1' to a pin; thence S. 23 W. 56.1' to a stake; thence S. 67-05 E. 155' to the beginning corner. This being the same land conveyed to Perry Simpson by Mollie Simpson February 28, 1920 by Deed recorded in Book 63 at Page 200. It being the intent of this conveyance to convey all the interest of the grantors in said property, the consideration recited to be divided amongst the various heirs of Perry Simpson in proportion to their interest in the lot.
