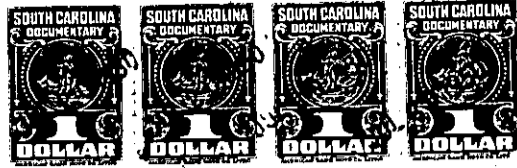

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Richard I. Tollison, Jr. in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and Seventy-Five and No/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lona Belle Taylor, her heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot No. 6 of the property of Conestee as shown on plat thereof prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, December 1943 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K", at page 276, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Fourth Avenue, which point is 10 feet from the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7 South 61-20 East and running thence with the South side of Fourth Avenue South 61-20 East 75 feet to the joint corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence South 28-40 West 75 feet to corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence with line of Lots 3 and 4 South 50-20 West 107.6 feet to joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 3; thence with line of Lot No. 2, North 61-20 West 45 feet to joint corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence with the new line in a Northeasterly direction 175 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and being all of Lot No. 6 except a 10-foot strip which is triangular in shape.

It is distinctly understood and agreed that the water line crossing said lot is to remain the property of the Grantor and he shall have the right to go on said property for the purpose of repairing and maintaining said water line. The Grantee shall have the right to tap on said line as now built.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee(s)'s Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
