Begginning at an iron pin on the East side of Barton Street, or Alley at a point approximately 130 feet North of the corner of said Barton alleyand the Old Buncombe Road and running thence N. 79 E., 1.821/4chains, more or less, to a stake in line of the Union Bleachery property, thence along the line of said Bleachery property, N. 1/2 W., 1.33 Chains, more or less, to a stake, thence S.79W, 2xxx 2.15chains to a stake on Barton Street, thence along the line of said Street, S.13 3/4 E,1.29 cahins, more or less, to the beginning corner.
