WHEREAS on or about 24 June 1947, I, as Supervisor of Greenville County, entered into an agreement with College Park Realty Corporation and William S. H. Piper and Ruth M. Piper, owners of certain real estate known as University Park and more fully described on a plat recorded in the RMC Office of Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at page 127 and;

WHEREAS under said agreement, Greenville County was to abandon a portion of a dirt road entering the northern side of U. S. Highway No. 29 at approximately a forty degree angle at a point approximately four hundred feet northeast of the intersection of the street now shown on the above reference plat as Brookside Circle and U. S. Highway No. 29; said dirt road continuing to run in approximately a forty degree angle westerly from said Highway No. 29 and entering what is now Brookside Circle at approximately lot No. 30 on said plat, or at a point approximately two hundred twenty feet from the intersection of said Brookside Circle and U. S. Highway No. 29, and;

WHEREAS said abandonment by the County of said dirt road was to effect the portion thereof from Brookside Circle to the entrance of said dirt road into U. S. Highway No. 29, and;

WHEREAS said abandonment was in consideration of the College Park Realty Company opening a new 60 foot street shown on the above referenced plat as Brookside Circle and said Brookside Circle was so opened and subsequently conveyed to and accepted by the County of Greenville in place and in lieu of said dirt road, and;

WHEREAS said agreement was confirmed by a written instrument signed by the supervisor of said Greenville County but said agreement has been lost or misplaced;

NOW THEREFORE, in order that said agreement as to the abandonment of said dirt road may be confirmed, I, as supervisor of Greenville County do hereby confirm said agreement as stated above and do further confirm that said dirt road was, in fact, abandoned.
