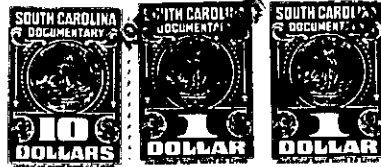

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leo B. Skinner and Zula Skinner, their heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of S. C., located about 1 & 1/2 miles SW of the Town of Greer on the north side of the Hammett Bridge Road, the same being known and designated as lots no. 9, 10, 11, 22, and 23 on a plat of the property of Paul L. Henderson, made by H. L. Dunahoo, surveyor, dated Aug. 23, 1950, and recorded in Vol. \_\_\_\_\_, Pg. \_\_\_\_\_, R. L. C. office for Greenville County and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

BEGINNING at a point on the western edge of a newly cut 36 foot street and 221.5 feet from the intersection of said newly cut street and Hammett Bridge Road, joint corner of lots 1 and 9 and running thence along the western edge of said newly cut street, N 45-00 W 625 feet to a stake, joint corner of lots 11 and 12; thence S 47-00 W 754 feet to a stake on the eastern edge of another newly cut 36 foot street, joint corner of lots 11 and 21; thence along the eastern edge of said lastmentioned newly cut street S 39-30 E 630 feet to a stake; joint corner of lots 8 and 23; thence N 47-15 E 814.5 feet to the point of beginning.
