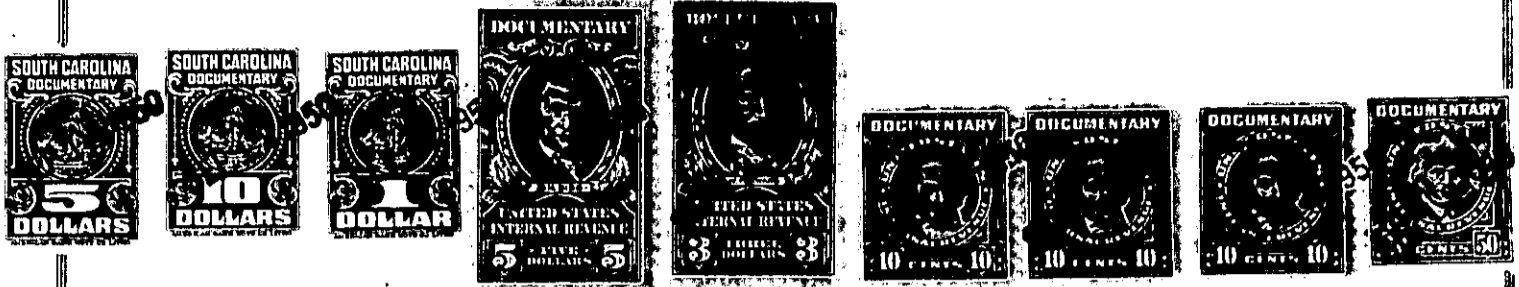

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said... Caroline B. Moseley, her heirs and...
assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the im-
provements thereon situate, lying and being on the East side of the
Davidson Road in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C.,
containing 27.33 acres according to survey made by C. C. Jones,
Engineer, August 17, 1950 and having according to said survey the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Davidson Road said
point being where the Davidson Road crosses East Poor House Branch
and running thence with the center of Davidson Road N. 25-30 E. 210
feet to a point; thence continuing with said Road N. 33-30 E. 202
feet to a point; thence still with the Road N. 11-30 E. 350 feet to
a point; thence continuing with the center of Davidson Road N. 13-
0 E. 173 feet to property now of Epps, formerly Reddin; thence along
line formerly of Reddin but now of Epps, Gamble and Batson S. 64-42E.
1338.8 feet to a point in center of Langston Creek; thence S. 52-51 W.
735 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-15 W. 426 feet to an iron pin;
thence S. 1-58 W. 177 feet to a point in the center of Langston Creek;
thence down Langston Creek following the center thereof (the traverse
lines being S. 81-04 W. 126.8 feet; S. 67-19 W. 487.3 feet) to fork
of Langston Creek and East Poor House Branch; thence up East Poor
House Branch following the center thereof in a Northerly direction
(the traverse lines being N. 5-43 E. 287.3 feet; N. 9-20 E. 368 feet;
N. 18-42 W. 56.6 feet; N. 75-04 W. 57.3 feet) to a point in center of
Davidson Road, the beginning corner.

This property is shown as all of Lots 76 and 86 on plat No. 2
of Parker Land Company, made by A. S. Bedell, April, 1914, recorded
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book E, page
276 and Plat Book F, page 276-277.
