KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Dr. Stanley I. Coleman, of Travelers Rest, South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the selling and delivery of these persons, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, and sell, and have by these presents granted, bargained, and sold to J. M. Johnson all standing timber eight (8) inches in diameter measured eight (8) inches above the surface of the ground, on all that certain parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, said State, about twelve (12) miles West of the City of Greenville and on the Southeast side of Geer Highway, being a portion of the land conveyed to me by N. O. McDowell in several deeds, and more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a farm road near my barn, and following the road in a southeasterly direction, and continuing along the said road with my property line to the fork of the road at a corner of Section C on McDowell Plat; thence following one fork of the road in a western direction with my line around the rear portion of my premises to the intersection of this road and a road by the Foster property; thence turning in an easterly direction with my property line to Foster's corner of Section A of the plat; thence in a southern direction to my corner on the branch; thence up the said branch to the fork; thence in a northern direction with a small branch to a corner of the New Ground; thence following the southwest portion of the New Ground to the beginning corner more fully shown on a plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, August, 1949.
