

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Easterly side of Wilshire Drive (formerly Brookwood Drive) in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lots 7 and 8, Block "G" on the Plat of Stone Estates as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", page 292, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Easterly side of Wilshire Drive at a point 151.2 feet North of the Northeast corner of the intersection of Wilshire Drive and Reid Street, joint front corner of lots 6 and 7 and thence along the joint lines of said lots S 78-38 E 1/9.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 10-30 E 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 8 and 9; thence along the joint line of lots 8 and 9 N 78-38 W 1/8.8 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of Wilshire Drive; thence along the Easterly side of Wilshire Drive S 11-22 W 50 feet to the point of beginning.
