All of that parcel or tract of land situate and being in Oneal Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, in School District No. 315, lying on the northwest side of the Mays Bridge Road-a moad that runs southwestardly from the Gap Creek Road at the Village of Oneal across South Tyger River, bounded on the North and West by lands of William McAbee, on the East by lands of Benjamin F. Compton and B.P. Mason, formerly Ollie Bell Frady; on the South and Southwest by lands of Benjamin F. Compton, by Duncan and by South Tyger River, having the following courses and distances, to wit: BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Mays Bridge Road (stake on North bank of the Road), corner with tract now or formerly owned by B.P. Mason and on line of Benjamin F. Compton land, and runs thence with the Mason line N. 37.00 W. 835 feet to a stake on William McAbee's line; thence with his line S. 21.20 W. 471 feet to a stone (old corner); thence continuing with McAbee's line S. 41.50 W. 1439 feet to an iron pin; thence with McAbee's line S. 60.00 W. 1054 feet to South Tyger River (stone on bank of said river); thence down and with the meanders of said river as the line about 1760 feet to a post oak 3x, Walker E. Duncan's corner; thence with Duncan's line N. 46.40 E. about 1430 feet to a point in the center of Mays Bridge Road, corner with Benjamin F.
