Furman University (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....Furman University, its successors and assigns, forever:

- All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the West side of the Watkins Bridge Road and the West side of the road leading South from the Watkins Bridge Road to Duncan Chapel Road in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lots 20 and 21 on Plat of P. K. Thackston property made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, September 1939, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "K", pages 23-24 and having according to a recent survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, November, 1950, the following motor and bounds. lowing metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of an unnamed County Road leading South from the Watkins Bridge Road to the Duncan Chapel Road at joint front corner of Tracts 19 and 20 and running thence along line of property now or formerly of Simkins N. 43-33 W. 1793.8 feet to a point in the center of the right-of-way of the Greenville & Northern Railroad thence with the center of said right-of-way N. 32-30 E. 159.60 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of said right-of-way N. 27-47 E. 173.28 feet to a point; thence still with the center of the right of way of the Greenville & Northern Railroad N. 20-41 E. 188.20 feet to a point in the center of said right-of-way corner of property now or formerly of Moody; thence along Moody line S. 58-11 E. 1374.5 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of property now or formerly of Hester; thence along the Hester line S. 56-34 E. 209.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Hester line S. 44-0 E. 116.60 feet to a point in the center of the Watkins Bridge Road; thence along the center of the Watkins Bridge Road S. 29-24 W. 193.50 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of the Watkins Bridge Road S. 3-19 W. 195.11 feet to a point; thence continuing with said road S. 4-11 E. 197.78 feet to a point at the center of the intersection of said Wat-kins Bridge Road with the unnamed County Road leading South therefrom to the Duncan Chapel Road; thence along the center of said unnamed Road S. 46-35 W. 238.6 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of said unnamed County Road S. 53-52 W. 192.89 feet to the beginning corner and contains 29,60 acres more or less.
