the Most Reverend John J. Russell, Bishop of Charleston, a Corporation sole,

All that certain lot or parcel of land in the State of South Carolina and Greenville County and in the City of Greenville on the North side of West Washington Street, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the joint corner of Lots 1 and 2 on the North side of West Washington Street and running thence, with the joint lines of said Lots 1 and 2, One Hundred feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence along a line parallel with Washington Street Twenty feet to the joint corner of Lots 2 and 3; thence along the joint lines of Lots 2 and 3, One Hundred feet to West Washington Street; thence along said West Washington Street Twenty feet to the beginning corner, having such metes and bounds as are shown on plat of Norwood property made by W.D. Neves, Engineer, on May 24, 1920.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to John M. Timmons by deed of W.M. Norwood, et al, dated June 30, 1920 and recorded in Deed Book 69 at page 75 and conveyed by the heirs of John M. Timmons to the grantee herein by deed dated July 22, 1950. The purpose of this deed is to vest in the grantee any right, title or claim I may have to said property by reason of the omission of my dower renunciation in deed from W.M. Norwood, et al, to John M. Timmons above referred to.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his successors and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee(s)'s Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
